**Description of Scholarship & Instructions for Applying**

**Award Amount**

- Available pool: \$5,000
- More than one scholarship may be awarded as determined by the selection committee

**Purpose of scholarship**

- The purpose of this scholarship is to support doctoral study for alumni who have received either bachelor's or master's degrees from Northeastern Illinois University who meet the specified criteria as stipulated by the donor, Dr. Bernard J. Brommel.

**Scholarship Criteria**

**Enrollment Requirement:**

- Must be a first or second year student admitted to and enrolled for a minimum of 9 credit hours per semester in a Ph.D. Program (any field) or PSY.D program, which is accredited by the North Central Association or equivalent Ph.D. accrediting agency. Students enrolled in online programs via for-profit institutions and Ed.D. doctoral programs are not eligible to apply.

**OR**

- If enrolled in a dual master's and doctoral program, the applicant must have completed 32 credit hours beyond their bachelor's degree.

**NEIU Alumnus Requirement:**

- Must have completed an NEIU bachelor's degree in the College of Arts and Sciences or the College of Education and must have received a master's degree from any institution in any of the fields within Arts and Sciences or the area of Counselor Education or Psychology.

**OR**

- Must have completed a master's degree from NEIU in the fields within Arts and Sciences or the areas of Counselor Education or Psychology and completed a bachelor's degree from NEIU or any institution within the areas of Arts & Sciences or Education.

**Additional Requirement:**

A strong research background, published articles and/or papers presented at state or regional conferences is highly desirable.
