#### Differences between Subsidized and Unsubsidized Direct Loans ...

**Subsidized Loans:** Are based on financial need, as determined by the federal need analysis process; interest is paid by the federal government while the borrower is in school at least half-time, throughout the six month grace period and during periods of deferment. The Financial Aid Office will automatically review your subsidized eligibility.

**Unsubsidized Loans:** Are not based on the student's financial need; and the borrower is responsible for the interest from the date the funds are disbursed. The Financial Aid Office will not review this eligibility unless you check this box.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen or national or eligible non-citizen
- Be enrolled on at least a half-time basis in an eligible degree or certificate-granting program
- Comply with Selective Service registration requirements
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as established by the University
- Student at Large statuses are not eligible for Title IV assistance
- Not be in default on any student loan or owe a refund on a grant
