# **Technical Notes on Program Retention Rates**

#### Definition

Program retention is the number and percentage of students seeking a degree in one of the academic programs who enroll from fall-to-fall at the university or have graduated.

#### Retention Rate Calculation

Program retention rates are calculated based on the number of students who were declared in one of the academic programs and registered for the next consecutive fall semester <u>or graduated</u> during the period indicated.

- Numerator: Number of students in cohort (denominator) enrolling in the next consecutive fall semester or having awarded a degree in the program from the institution during the specified academic year.
- Denominator: Number of undergraduate students who have declared (by census date) a first major or a second major in one of the academic programs and enroll in the fall semester of a specified academic year.

#### Retention by Degree Programs by College and by Nontraditional Degree Programs

- Students with double majors are counted in both programs.
- If a degree is awarded to a student who was not enrolled at the beginning of the specified academic year (e.g., student paid a balance due), that student is not included in the analysis
- If a student declares a major after the beginning of the specified academic year <u>and</u> graduates during the same period, that student is not included in the analysis.
- Note that the interdisciplinary program B.A. in Global Studies is grouped with programs in Arts and Sciences.

#### Retention by Premajor Programs

• The table provides the fall-to-fall retention rates of undeclared undergraduates who were enrolled in pre-major programs by the census date in the fall term of the specified academic year.

#### Retention by Student Classification

• The table provides the fall-to-fall retention rates of undergraduate students in two groups, declared and undeclared majors. The undeclared group includes degree-seeking students (program code D399 and pre-majors) and non-degree-seeking students-at-large (program code A000) who were enrolled by the census date in the fall term of the specified academic year.

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
