POLICY

From the 23 Illinois Administrative Code 1050.

ii) Baccalaureate degree requires at least 120 semester credit hours or 180 quarter credit hours and at least 40 semester credit hours (60 quarter credit hours) in upper-division courses.

Course Numbers

100- and 200-level courses are lower division.

300-level courses are upper division courses which are for advanced undergraduates and, under some conditions, graduate students.

Undergraduate students must complete a minimum of 40 semester hours at the upper division level.

Bachelor's Degree Requirements

Undergraduate students eligible to graduate from Northeastern must earn a minimum of 120 semester hours, 30 of which must be earned at Northeastern. Undergraduate students must complete a minimum of 40 semester hours at the 300 level.
