Undergraduate Major Declaration Form Instructions

- 1) Declare a major or pre-major by the time you have earned 45 semester hours.
- 2) Select only one major or pre-major per form. declaring Students declaring both a major and a minor will need one of each form.
- 3) Indicate the declaration or removal (undeclaring) of a major. Also, in the body of the form, select the major that is to be declared or removed (undeclared).
- 4) Either submit the completed form to Enrollment Management Services (D-101) or email the completed form to declare@neiu.edu for processing.

Remove (Undeclare) Your Major

Students who no longer wish to major in a previously declared area can use this form to A) indicate at the top of the form that they are removing a major and B) indicate the no longer desired major. No program advisor signature is required. (See #4 above for submission instructions).

Pre-Majors

Students intending to major in business or graphic design, can declare a "Pre-Major" until the program admission requirements to the College of Business and Technology or to the BFA in Graphic Design are met. Indicate at the top of the form that they are declaring a major, select the desired pre-major and obtain the approval of the program. (See #4 above for submission instructions)

Once the program admission requirements are met, students will need to formally declare the Business or Graphic Design major by completing and submitting a new Undergraduate Major Declaration form.

K-12 Licensure Programs

In addition to declaring your K-12 Licensure program with the Daniel L. Goodwin College of Education, students must declare a major in their discipline with the College of Arts and Sciences.

Accelerated Programs

In addition to declaring an accelerated program with their undergraduate program advisor, students participating in an Accelerated Pathways Program must also obtain the signature of the graduate advisor overseeing the corresponding graduate program. The Declaration will not be processed without both advisors' signatures.
