



Show runs through November 29



REDISCOVERING CREATIVITY: My Journey into Ceramics

Ceramics is new to me but has been exciting to explore at a time when I've felt a little burnt out in other areas. It is a relaxing way to focus my energy when I'm feeling busy and all over the place.


There are challenges to ceramics that I wasn't expecting but overall it has been lots of fun. We just started working on the wheel which has been about as difficult as I expected but also enjoyable and meditative. I definitely like the wheel more than I thought I would.

Working in a new medium has allowed me to take a step back from ones I am more used to and have felt a little stuck in. Because I don't have much experience in ceramics I've put less pressure on myself and have felt more free and playful when creating art than I had been feeling lately. I think this also comes with the material itself since clay is so malleable and working with it is so tactile. This has allowed me to rediscover some of my own tastes and reminded me of what I like to make, leading me to feel more inspired in other areas like drawing. It is also a fun challenge to try and transform a sketch into something tangible. It's good practice in accepting that your work won't turn out exactly as planned and enjoying that process.

I will definitely continue making ceramics in the future and I'm excited to see what I'll make next!
