

The NEIU Alumni Association Internship Scholarship

Purpose:

To support and recognize an NEIU student who will be involved in an internship opportunity at Northeastern Illinois University or at a for-profit company, government entity, or non-profit agency.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a degree seeking sophomore, junior, or senior student
- Minimum 3.50 cumulative grade point average
- Open to any major
- Must submit an Internship program proposal as approved by faculty advisor and/or Career Development Center Staff.

Award amount:

• A maximum of six scholarships are awarded per academic year. Award amount is subject to change pending applicant pool and eligibility. Award given out in two installments during the semester based upon engagement in the program.

Application Submission Deadline:

• The application deadline for Spring 2025 is November 1, 2024. The deadline for Fall 2025 is September 1, 2025.
